Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The project output was a three-day event consisting of lectures, expert meetings, webinars, analyses, discussions, workshops and socio-cultural complementary activities of the event. The project outputs were compiled based on the needs of the target group and the pre-determined goals of the applicant and representatives of the partner municipalities. The project outputs directly influenced the behaviour of the project participants. By spreading and passing on the main ideas of the project, we achieved an interactive understanding of the facts, which was reflected in EU citizens regardless of whether they participated or not in the prepared event. The expected results of the project can be summarized as follows:

- Maintaining the rules of non-discrimination in society
- Gender equality in EU countries
- Applying knowledge to spread the importance of European initiatives discussed in the project
- Social habits related to environmental protection
- Certification of new work habits and procedures in the management of national and transnational projects
- Division of work activities based on compliance with the rules of gender equality

The power of history and solidarity! 25.10.2024

The first day of the event was dedicated to welcoming and introducing guests from partner municipalities. This was followed by the launch of craft markets and the activity "Respect for the Elderly" - a festive lunch and gathering for seniors. The local organization - the Slovak Red Cross participated in facilitating the possibility of voluntary blood donation for the participants of the event. The lectures held at the event on the first day were aimed at gaining a general overview of the community of nations of the European Union. The lectures focused on the areas of history and diversity, European citizenship, democracy, euroscepticism, solidarity and the EU Charter of Fundamental Human Rights. The end of the first day of the event programme was accompanied by a dance performance by students of the Tomášov Elementary School and a cultural and social performance by musical groups in cooperation with the local organization Csemadok.

The power of gender equality! 26.10.2024

The second day of the event focused on promoting gender equality in the society of EU countries. The beginning of the day was accompanied by language games for children (boxed language games focusing on developing vocabulary in the English language) and a voluntary collection to help civilians from Ukraine called "Hear with the Heart". Meetings of experts, a webinar and a lecture on the topic of gender equality clarified the policy of equal opportunities in the education of students and equal remuneration of men and women in selected job positions (equality and personality of a person). Subsequently, we proceeded to a discussion about the impact of the pandemic on the social life of EU citizens. The evening festivities associated with wine tasting by local and foreign winemakers consisted in building friendly relations between partner municipalities.

The power of European Union! 27.10.2024

The last day of the event began with a voluntary mass in the Roman Catholic Church of St. Nicholas combined with a tour of the manor house in Tomášov. The added value of the event was the inclusion of environmental protection principles in the event programme in the form of an interactive lecture on the New European Bauhaus movement - Destination Station Europe. Educational activities consisted of a discussion with representatives of partner municipalities about the future of municipalities, partnership, Europe and also in the form of an educational workshop on the development of social and work ethics in the environment of EU countries. The event concluded with a discussion on the advantages of partner countries' membership in the EU and the end of the event itself, thanking the participants and project partners.

We identified the project results as immediate changes in the behaviour of individuals, which we achieved through the implemented activities of the event programme. The added value characterized by the expansion of the programme topics influenced the understanding of the essence of environmental protection in connection with the New European Bauhaus movement. We maintained gender equality and habits related to communication activities (radio, poster, division of tasks - women and men in equal proportions) even after the end of the project, because we pointed out the importance and strength of the community, as long as neither gender felt the discriminatory features of the gender-oriented characteristics of the individual. We ensured the sustainability of the project results by a gradual increase in pro-European-oriented EU citizens. Volunteering and solidarity with civilians in Ukraine was a demonstration of the acceptance of the Charter of Fundamental Human Rights and the UN Convention. We perceive the project results primarily as the formation of society in the area of issues and problems discussed at the event with the aim of preventing a contradictory society with signs of violence and discrimination.
